### **General Announcements & Reminders**

#### FINRA CAT Announcements

- ➤ Updated Phase 2a/2b and Phase 2c Industry Member Technical Specifications are scheduled to be published on 4/22/2020.
- > Intrafirm Linkage validations are live in the Test Environment.
  - Intrafirm statistics are available via the Reporter Portal and machine to machine feedback files are available no later than T+1 at noon.
- > The Industry Member Onboarding Guide and Reporter Portal User Guide have been updated and will be posted by 4/22/2020.
- > The SEC issued an exemptive order permitting introducing brokers that meet certain requirements to follow the Small Industry Member reporting timeline.
- The SEC issued an exemptive order establishing a phased CAT reporting timeline for Industry Members.

#### FINRA CAT Observations

#### File Submission – FINRA CAT Recommended Practice

- File Submissions should be one file per IMID within specified file maximums:
  - CAT Reporter Portal: 1GB uncompressed/100,000 records
  - Machine-to-Machine: 100GB uncompressed
- > Benefit to Submitters:
  - Fewer files for submitter to manage
  - Expedited feedback response

Note: SFTP (Machine-to-Machine) is **not** limited by 1GB/100,000 record limits on the Reporter Portal. Files may be up to **100GB** uncompressed which can contain significantly more than 100,000 records. As stated above, feedback times will be faster with fewer files.

#### FINRA CAT Intrafirm Observations

- orderKeyDate of the secondary event must reference the orderKeyDate of its associated primary event. Referencing the eventTimestamp instead of the orderKeyDate will result in an Unlinked Error on the secondary event.
- ➤ When populated, the *routedOrderID* on the order modification event must be unique. Reusing the same *routedOrderID* across events will result in a Route Key Duplicate Error.

#### FINRA CAT Reminders

- > The Production Environment is open and able to receive files. Industry Members have both successfully accessed the Production Environment and submitted files.
- > All Test Symbols (equity and options) will be rejected in the Production Environment.
- To ensure all securities reportable during any given transaction date are identified for reporting, firms are encouraged to use both the SOD and EOD files.
- ➤ The processing date of all submissions will be assigned based on the received timestamp of the associated metadata file. If a data file is received prior to T+1 8:00 AM EST with the associated metadata file submitted after T+1 8:00 AM EST, the submissions will be considered late.
- Duo MFA had not planned to support devices running end-of-life operating systems after April 13, 2020; this has been deferred to a later date.

#### FINRA CAT Reminders

- ➤ File Acknowledgement is anticipated to be delivered within 10 minutes of file submission and no later than 1 hour of file submission. Submitters should not resubmit files earlier than 1 hour after original file submission.
- > The following are available in the Production Environment and Test Environment: export on error search, Market Center ID of "LT", and Group Repair expanded from 500 to 10,000 records.
- > The Group Repair eligibility logic has been enhanced. As a result, records eligible for Group Repair will not be marked with 'Y' for dates prior to April 13, 2020 in the Test Environment (Production Environment is not affected by this enhancement).
- The SEC approved the Participant's request for exemptive relief to allow Participants and Industry Members to truncate timestamps captured in increments more granular than nanoseconds to nanoseconds for submission to CAT.
- Rather than the previously scheduled Daily Industry Checkpoint Calls, Consolidated Audit Trail, LLC and FINRA CAT, LLC will maintain our Weekly Industry Checkpoint Calls on Tuesdays at 4:15 pm ET until further notice.

## Onboarding – Certification of Production Readiness Testing

- ➤ Once CAT Reporters have completed **all** onboarding steps, including the successful completion of the Production Readiness Testing, each IM and CRA must contact the FINRA CAT Helpdesk (888-696-3348 or <a href="help@finracat.com">help@finracat.com</a>).
- > The FINRA CAT Helpdesk will require the Processing Date(s) on which the testing occurred.
- Upon verification of the Production Readiness Testing and all other Onboarding Steps by FINRA CAT, CAT Reporters will be granted access to the CAT Production Environment, and a notification confirming access will be sent.


