Exchange Linkage Update

- Exchange unmatched rates are approximately:
 - Less than 1% for equities exchanges
 - Since December 11, 2020, several options exchange and Industry Member fixes went into production. As a result, the options exchange route unmatched rate has declined to less than 8%.

CAT NMS Plan, Exemptive Relief and Interpretive Updates

Amendments

None since the last Monthly CAT Implementation Update (November 19, 2020)

Exemptive Relief Requests and Orders

- On December 4, 2020, the Plan Participants submitted to the SEC a request for <u>exemptive</u> relief from certain provisions of the CAT NMS Plan related to the resubmission of corrected data to the CAT by T+3 at 8 am ET.
- On December 4, 2020, the Plan Participants submitted to the SEC a request for <u>exemptive</u> relief from certain provisions of the CAT NMS Plan related to initial data validation, lifecycle linkages and communication of errors by T+1 at noon ET.
- On December 16, 2020, the SEC issued an <u>order</u> of temporary conditional exemptive relief from certain requirements in the CAT NMS Plan related to: (1) timeframes for lifecycle linkages; (2) re-processing of corrections received after T+5; (3) linkage of Participant Data and Industry Member Data with SIP Data; (4) reporting of port-level settings applicable to orders; (5) lifecycle linkage between customer orders and representative orders; and (6) Participant reporting of rejected orders. The duration of the exemptive relief period applicable to each issue varies, as described further in the order.

New FAQs

- 4 New FAQs published since the last Monthly CAT Implementation Update (November 19, 2020).
 - B68 regarding populating the *accountHolderType* field if an Industry Member uses the same account for both market making and non-market making proprietary activity.
 - B69 regarding how the *price* and *eventTimestamp* fields should be populated on a New Order event/Order Accepted event for a trade priced at the Net Asset Value ("NAV") with no offset.
 - B70 regarding how the *price* and *eventTimestamp* fields should be populated on a Trade event for a trade priced at the Net Asset Value ("NAV") with no offset.
 - D36 regarding whether the *handlingInstructions* value of 'CSC' should be reported to CAT if an order is being worked by an algorithm that may utilize strategies that work the order in a way similar to a spread condition.

Updated FAQs

- 3 Updated FAQs published since the last Monthly CAT Implementation Update (November 19, 2020).
 - No change in guidance:
 - B63- added additional examples describing how the *initiator* field should be populated if an Industry Member modifies or cancels an order based on implicit customer instructions communicated with the order.
 - B66- clarified when to use an Order Effective event/Option Order Effective event and when it is not required.
 - K10- Updated the spreadsheet embedded in FAQ K10 regarding the protocols that qualify for the exemption for Options Market Maker quotes. MIAX added a new order protocol that does not qualify for the quote exemption.
