IM Tech Spec Updates

IM Tech Spec Publications

On 10/8/2021, the Phase 2d v4.0.0 r11 (clean and redline) IM Tech Specs were published. These updates are in support of Phase 2d go-live.

Added Fields

- Added deptType to the MLOA event.
- Added clearingFirm to the MOOT event.
- These two fields will be available in the Phase 2d Industry Test environment and PROD environments starting 11/29 and 12/13, respectively as optional fields. They will become required in early 2022.

Field Changes

- Changed *electronicTimestamp* field from Conditional to Optional on MEOT and MOOT events.
- Changed numberOfLegs field from Required to Optional on MLCR, MLIC, MLICR, and MLCOC events.
- Changed pairedOrderID field from Conditional to Optional on MEOR, MEOA, MOOA, and MLOA events.

Field Description Changes

- Updated description of pairedOrderID field.
- Updated description of minQty field.
- Updated description of *TIDType* field on MEPA, MEAA, MOPA, and MOAA events.
- Updated description of eventTimestamp field on MEPA and MOPA events to align with FAQ U9.
- ▶ Update description of *price* on MLNO, MLOR, MLMR, MLOA, MLIR, MLIM, MLIMR, MLCO, MLCOM, MLOM, and MLOMR events.

Added/Removed Allowable Values

- Added handlingInstructions values 'ERP', 'MAX' and 'PCS'.
 - ERP: Exchange Retail Provider An order routed to an exchange to interact with retail orders as part of a retail pricing program.
 Pricing, display and counterparty eligibility for exchange retail provider orders are subject to the rules of the receiving exchange.
 - MAX : OTC Link ATS Message MAX instruction. Reflects the maximum number of shares to be executed between selected market makers.
 - PCS: Position Compression Service Indicates that the order is to be executed through an exchange position compression service.
- Removed handlingInstructions value 'LCE'.
- Removed allocationType value 'AVP'.

Clarified Allowable Values

- Changed the definition of handlingInstructions value 'OFF'.
 - Changed from "Price includes offset" to "Priced with specific offset".
- Updated the definition of initiator value 'C'.
 - Changed from "Initiated by the Customer" to "Initiated by the Customer/Client".

Linkage Key Updates

- Corrected definitions of the following 2 linkage keys.
- MEOT Exchange Trade Linkage Key
 - Event Date, symbol, tapeTradeID, marketCenterID
- MLOA Route Linkage Key
 - Event Date, senderIMID, receiverIMID, routedOrderID

Additional Clarifications

- Clarified requirements for reporting Route, Route
 Modified and Route Cancelled Supplement events.
 - IMs may choose to report the routeRejectedFlag on either the original route event or a supplement regardless of when the IM became aware of the rejected route.
- Clarified requirements for reporting handlingInstructions 'RAR'.
 - 'RAR' handlingInstructions is applicable for external routes only.
- Clarified requirements for pairedOrderID in Section 3.7.

Additional Clarifications - cont.

- Replaced Electronic Paired Option Order with Paired Option Order in Glossary.
 - For CAT reporting purposes, a Paired Option Order is defined as an electronic option order that contains both the initial and contra side that is routed as a single message to an exchange for crossing and/or price improvement.
- Updated/clarified FDID Plan Language, references, masking requirements and change/replacement guidance in Section 2.4.2.

Other Updates

- Removed OATS references.
- Updated references to "customer" and/or "client".
- Updated representativeInd and fulfillmentLinkType fields' values 'YE' and 'YP' to remind IMs that linkages will be required when exemptive relief expires on July 31, 2023.
- Added Section 7.5.1.7 for Linkage Key Format.
 - CAT derived linkage keys will be included in the linkage feedback.

Error Codes

- Added new Error Codes 2219, 2220, and 2221.
 - 2219: Invalid side in buyDetails
 - 2220: Invalid side in sellDetails
 - 2221: Invalid combination of symbol and openCloseIndicator fields in legDetails
- Updated multiple Error Codes in Appendix E to include references to the new events in Phase 2d.
