# Correspondents and Clearing Firms with Correspondents: Use of the *correspondentCRD* field

### Introduction

- Correspondents/Introducing Broker-Dealers ("IBDs") and clearing firms have their own separate and distinct CAIS obligations.
  - See the March 1, 2022 Full Customer & Account Reporting 101 industry webinar for illustrations and examples.
- An Industry Member's CAIS reporting obligation derives from its Transaction reporting obligation.
- In a typical correspondent/clearing firm scenario, the correspondent has the obligation to report the new order event (for example, the MENO) and the clearing firm has the obligation to report the allocation event (for example, the MEPA).
- In this scenario:
  - The correspondent also has an obligation to report to CAIS the firmDesignatedID populated on the new order event.
  - The clearing firm also has an obligation to report to CAIS the *firmDesignatedID* populated on the allocation event.

### Which Industry Members Must Populate the correspondentCRD field

- When reporting a firmDesignatedID to CAIS:
  - The *correspondentCRD* field is only populated by clearing firms with correspondents/IBDs and only when reporting accounts that are custodied for their correspondents/IBDs, including DVP/RVP accounts.
    - Clearing firms without correspondents/IBDs must not populate the correspondentCRD field.
    - Clearing firms reporting firmDesignatedIDs that are not associated with a correspondent/IBD (such as a proprietary account) must not populate the correspondentCRD field.
    - Correspondents/IBDs must <u>not</u> populate the correspondentCRD field.

### Use of the *correspondentCRD* Field: Who and When

<sup>\*</sup>For purposes of this presentation, "Third Party CRA" is a non-Industry Member CAT Reporting Agent.

### Use of the correspondentCRD Field- Other Highlights

- Clearing firms reporting accounts that are custodied for their correspondents/IBDs must populate the correspondentCRD field with the CRD number of the related IBD or correspondent firm.
- The correspondentCRD field is at the main level within the JSON structure of the CAIS Data File, and as such will apply to all records within the file.
- All FDID and Customer data included in the file will be associated to the catReporterCRD and correspondentCRD pairing.
- If the clearing firm custodies Accounts for multiple correspondents/IBDs, Accounts for each individual correspondent/IBD must be grouped into a separate file.
- The correspondentCRD field is separate and distinct from the clearingBrokerID field, which refers to the NSCC Clearing ID of the Industry Member that clears the Account.

### Illustrating Use of the correspondentCRD Field

- The following slides will illustrate how the *catReporterCRD*, *catSubmitterID* and *correspondentCRD* fields must be populated in five sample scenarios:
  - 1. When a correspondent/IBD has a CAIS reporting obligation
  - 2. When a clearing firm has a CAIS reporting obligation for an account it custodies for a correspondent/IBD
  - When a clearing firm has a CAIS reporting obligation for an account that is not associated with a correspondent/IBD
  - 4. When a clearing firm populates an erroneous CRD number in the correspondentCRD field
  - 5. When a clearing firm erroneously leaves the correspondentCRD field blank.

The final example will illustrate that a clearing firm reporting accounts that it custodies for multiple correspondents/IBDs must be submitted to CAIS in separate files.

### Illustrating Use of the correspondentCRD Field- The Identifiers

### Disclaimer

Note: All names, addresses, and identifiers data used for examples in the customer and Account information reports are purely fictional for illustrative purposes only. Any resemblance to actual persons, organizations, or locations is purely coincidental. All Transformed Identifiers ("TIDs") included in the examples for Social Security Numbers, Individual Taxpayer Identification Numbers, or Employer Identification Numbers (collectively, 'SSN/ITIN' and 'EIN'), are generated from values that are outside of the acceptable range of assignment by the assigning body, and would fail CAT data validations if actually reported to CAIS.

### Example - Typical Correspondent/Clearing Firm Relationship

- ▶ A customer originates an order at an introducing broker-dealer (IBFA).
- ▶ IBFA automatically routes all orders to its clearing firm (CLFA) who further routes all orders to an exchange for execution and allocates shares to customers' accounts.
- The customer places an order with IBFA and IBFA routes the order to CLFA. CLFA then routes the order to an exchange for execution. CLFA later allocates the shares to the customer's account.
- ▶ IBFA and CLFA maintain separate FDIDs for the customer's account.
- ▶ IBFA's CRD number is 9999 and CLFA's CRD number is 8888.

## Example - CAIS Reporting Requirements

- ▶ IBFA and CLFA each have their own separate and distinct CAIS reporting obligations.
  - IBFA must report to CAIS the *firmDesignatedID* populated on the MENO.
  - CLFA must report to CAIS the firmDesignatedID populated on the MEPA.

## Correspondent/IBD CAIS Data File Header

- These illustrations show how the file header must be populated when the correspondent/IBD has the CAIS reporting obligation.
- No matter if the correspondent/IBD is self-reporting or using a CAT Reporting Agent, the correspondentCRD field must not be populated.

- These illustrations show how the file header must be populated when the clearing firm has the CAIS reporting obligation for accounts it custodies for a correspondent/IBD.
- No matter if the clearing firm is self-reporting or using a CAT Reporting Agent, the *correspondentCRD* field must <u>always</u> be populated.

### Clearing Firm Reporting for its Own Accounts

Suppose that the clearing firm has accounts that are not associated with its IBDs (proprietary accounts or direct customer accounts):

No matter if the clearing firm is self-reporting or using a CAT Reporting Agent, the correspondentCRD field

must <u>not</u> be populated.

### Clearing Firm: Erroneous CRD in the correspondentCRD Field

- Suppose the clearing firm populated an erroneous CRD number in the correspondentCRD field:
  - The clearing firm must follow the Corrections process as described in the Full CAIS Technical Specifications
    - Corrections and updates are made by submitting the same FDID Record (with all current Customer and LTID associations), with corrected or updated data.
    - The new data provided on the corrected record will update the record currently stored in CAIS.

### Clearing Firm: correspondentCRD Field Erroneously Blank

- Suppose the clearing firm erroneously left the correspondentCRD field blank:
  - The clearing firm must follow the Corrections process as described in the Full CAIS Technical Specifications
    - Corrections and updates are made by submitting the same FDID Record (with all current Customer and LTID associations), with corrected or updated data.
    - The new data provided on the corrected record will update the record currently stored in CAIS.

### Clearing Firm: Reporting Multiple Correspondents/IBDs

Suppose the clearing firm custodies accounts for multiple correspondents/IBDs:

• It must submit the records in separate files- it cannot comingle the records for different correspondents/IBDs in a single file.

No matter if the clearing firm is self-reporting or using a CAT Reporting Agent, the correspondentCRD field

must <u>always</u> be populated.
