Add New Boolean Flag

 Add BFMMFlag as a conditional Boolean field (true/false) on MENO, MEOM, MEOT and MEOTS events to identify Short Sale orders originated or modified when relying on the bona fide Market Making exception under Rule 203(b)(2)(iii) of Regulation SHO.

The compliance date for BFMMFlag reporting is July 1, 2025.

Removal of *handlingInstructions* Values

• Remove 'MAO', 'MAC', 'AOB' and 'MOB' handlingInstructions values.

Schema Changes – New Field

- Added Boolean BFMMFlag as conditional field on MENO, MEOM, MEOT, and MEOTS events.
- Identifies if a Short Sale order event relies on the bona fide Market Making exception under Rule 203(b)(2)(iii) of Regulation SHO. Only applicable to Market Makers on security-by-security basis.
- When populated with a value of true, the side field must be populated with the value of 'SS' or 'SX' and the accountHolderType field value must be 'O'.
- This reporting supports the SEC's requirement to report reliance on the bona fide market making exception in Regulation SHO, in connection with the SEC's issuance of Release No. 34-98738. The compliance date for this reporting is July 1, 2025.

Schema Changes – New Field

Added Error Codes 2260, 2261 and 2262

<u>2260</u>	<u>Missing or Invalid</u> <u>BFMMFlag</u>	BFMMFlag must be populated with one of the allowable values.	Error
<u>2261</u>	Invalid combination of BFMMFlag and accountHolderType	The combination of BFMMFlag and accountHolderType must be valid.	<u>Error</u>
<u>2262</u>	Invalid combination of BFMMFlag and side	The combination of BFMMFlag and side must be valid.	Error

Schema Changes - Handling Instruction Removal

- ▶ Retired the 'MAO', 'MAC', 'AOB' and 'MOB' handlingInstructions values.
 - Market at Close Instructs the trader to execute the order at the closing inside quote price of regular market hours.
 - Market at Open Instructs the trader to execute the order at the opening inside quote price of regular market hours.
 - At or Between Instructs the trader to execute at a trade price equal to the NBBO or between the NBBO and the midpoint.
 - Midpoint or Better Instructs the trader to execute at a trade price equal to the midpoint or better.

Updates and Clarifications

- Clarified description of Boolean Data Type in Table 3: Data Types when field is optional, conditional or required.
 - A value with two choices: true or false. Boolean values are NOT case sensitive.
 - In CSV representation, when required field, the value must equal true or false (no quotation marks). If the field is optional or conditional and no value is reported, then the value is considered false in CSV representation.
 - In JSON representation, if the field is not present, the value is considered false for required, conditional and optional fields.

Updates and Clarifications

- Update the description of 'BIN' handlingInstructions value in Appendix
 G: Data Dictionary in conformance with recent updates to <u>CAT FAQ B37</u>.
 - Buy-In An order originated executed pursuant to SEC or SRO rules (e.g., to comply with the close out requirements of Regulation SHO or FINRA Rule 4320, or the buy-in requirement of SEA Rule15c3-3). Refer to CAT FAQ B37.
